### **High Density and Medium Density Fibreboards**

These planks are widely used to make kitchen cabinets, however they are not as durable or robust as plywood. The board's smoothness allows for careful finishing and painting to give a stunning appearance.

### **Particleboard**

Particleboard is the most cheap material for a modular kitchen in Noida. It is a very light substance made by pressing waste and sawdust together. Despite being the least resilient material, it cannot support weight.

### **Wood**

If you have the resources, you can decide to construct your kitchen from real wood. Real wood is tough to work with, thus most modular kitchen companies in Noida don't use it as their main material. Without the proper seasoning, it will eventually get distorted. Teak and rubberwood are the two most common types of wood on the market.

## **2. Exterior finishes and shutters**

PU, acrylic, or membrane coatings are also regularly found on modular kitchens, even though laminate is the finish that is used the most.

### **Laminate**

### **Membrane**

A thin membrane that entirely encircles the shutter's grooves, mouldings, and sides is used in its construction. Because of the smooth surface, outstanding longevity is guaranteed. It is PVC foil, which comes in matte, glossy, and wooden finishes. The membrane is currently the kitchen finish that is most popular.
